ABOUT PCCF

The Phelps County Community Foundation was established in 1976 through an estate gift from Irene Anderson, who envisioned the creation of a foundation to benefit Phelps County. Her initial gift of \$300,000 set the PCCF on a path to grow and significantly impact the lives of residents in the county. As of 2024, the foundation has assets exceeding \$30 million and continues to grow.

PCCF is led by a 12-member Board of Directors and currently employs three individuals. Our organization aims to be a community leader in our county through various programs and initiatives. PCCF has been involved in fundraising efforts for several projects, including The Tassel, the Don Sjogren Community YMCA, the Holdrege Veterans Memorial, and the Nebraska Prairie Museum.

PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES

- **SCHOLARSHIPS** - Because of the generosity of individuals, businesses, and organizations PCCF now holds over 90 scholarship funds to support the educational endeavors of graduating high school and college students.
- **GRANTS** - We partner with nonprofits to help them secure the funding they need to grow and thrive. PCCF has multiple grant opportunities for organizations in Phelps County to take advantage of including PCCF, Pearson Fund, and Women's' Giving Group.
- **give2GROW** - Is an annual giving day hosted by the Phelps County Community Foundation in November. This charitable event aims to connect donors with organizations that perform impactful and vital work in Phelps County.

MARCH-APRIL

GETTING STARTED

Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship through the Foundation. These scholarships are made possible by generous individuals, families, and organizations who wish to support others in their pursuit of higher education.

PCCF UNIVERSAL APPLICATION

PCCF uses a “universal application,” which means that as you complete your application, the information you provide will make you eligible for all the scholarships for which you qualify. The more details you include in your application, the more scholarships you may be considered for, so be sure to be as thorough as possible. This single application will determine your eligibility for over 90 different scholarship opportunities based on the information you provide.

CREATE ACCOUNT/SIGN IN

The link to the scholarship application can be found on PCCF's website, www.phelpsfoundation.org / What We do / Scholarships / Apply Now.

Create an account using a personal email address instead of a school email, as you will not have access to your school email account after graduation. PCCF will communicate with you via email throughout the scholarship process, so it is essential to use a personal email address.

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

TRANSCRIPTS

Official transcripts from colleges will need to be uploaded by the student. If you cannot upload it yourself, please email it to Lacy Chapman at lchapman@phelpsfoundation.org and she will be able to upload it to your application.

Any high school student taking college courses will need to also submit a transcript for all of the classes they have taken while in high school.

High school students will have their transcripts, class rank, GPA, and ACT score entered into their application by their guidance counselor.

SHOWCASE YOUR STORY

Your personal essays, along with any additional essays you write, allow you to highlight why you are a strong candidate for a scholarship. Make sure to craft a narrative that is engaging and personal, while also remembering not to include your name in any of your essays.

GRAMMAR & SPELLING MATTERS

It's essential that your scholarship essays are polished. We strongly encourage you to have someone else proofread your application before submitting it. Reviewers are evaluating many applications and face difficult decisions. Poor grammar and spelling errors can lead to your application being overlooked.

SHARE YOUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Please provide as much detail as possible about your activities, community service, work experience, church involvement, awards, honors, and anything else you are proud of in your application. The more information you include, the greater your chances may be of qualifying for additional scholarships!

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

REFERENCES

When preparing your application, it's important to select your references early. This ensures you have a backup in case one of your references is unable to complete their form on time. The individuals you choose to recommend you can significantly impact your application.

You can submit one academic reference, like a teacher or professor who knows your school work well. The rest of your references should come from individuals like employers, coaches, or mentors who can talk about your character and potential. Make sure to choose someone who can share specific examples of your strengths and support your application.

Keep in mind that family members can only be references if they are also your employer. Current board or staff members from PCCF cannot be your references either.

Think about whether your reference can add valuable insights about you. Sometimes what they share can really help your application stand out, especially if they know things about you that you didn't mention.

You won't be able to see what your references write, but you will know if they have completed the online form. This way, you can follow up with them to make sure everything is submitted on time.
